

Watercolor Classes

A watercolor painting class by J.D. Spencer will be offered at the June Convention in the afternoon for those who are interested. The class is free. Limited supplies will be available at the time of the class at cost.

List of supplies for Watercolor Classes

Three (3) full sheets (22"x30") Arches 140lb, Cold Pressed, Watercolor paper. (A limited amount of watercolor paper will be available for purchase @ \$7.00 per sheet)

Brushes suitable for watercolor:

- a. 1" or larger Aquarelle Flat
- b. # 10 or larger Round
- c. Rigger

A container to hold water, approx. 1 qt. in size, with a flat bottom

Watercolor Pigments:

- a. Cadmium Red Medium
- b. Alizarin Crimson or Carmine
- c. Cadmium Yellow Medium
- d. Hansa Yellow Medium
- e. Yellow Ochre
- f. Hooker's Green (if you do not want to make your own green)
- g. Burnt Sienna
- h. Cerulean Blue
- i. Cobalt Blue or French Ultramarine Blue
- j. Thalo Blue or Prussian Blue

These pigments are suggestions. But you will need a WARM and COOL pigment in, yellow, blue, red. Please feel free to bring any other pigments that you would like to use.

A Watercolor Palette or flat white plate, Styrofoam is ok, but paper plates will not work

A ridged board thin in thickness. Can even be very thick cardboard-like substance Size should be no smaller than 12" x 16" or no larger than 16" x 20" in size.

A permanent marker in black, no finer than Fine to Medium point.
