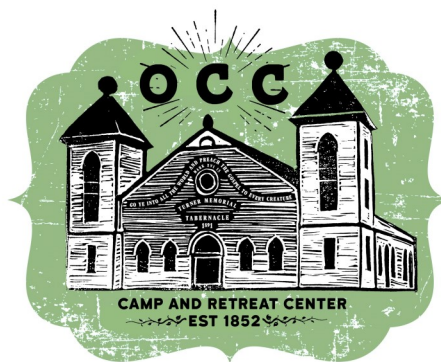
Theme:
